An easy pinwheel design using 2 1/2" pre-cut strips—a great quilt for using jelly rolls or for cleaning out your stash

Quilt size—57" x 75"

(Recipe for Cheese Puffs included.)

025 COUNTRY CHARM TABLE RUNNER

Here's a great way to use charm squares. Made with four-patch squares and half square triangles, this table runner will be satisfying for both beginners and more experienced quilters.

Finished Table Runner size—20" x 44 1/2"
Finished block size—12" (Recipe for Dilled Potato Soup included.)



022 CHINESE LANTERNS

Inspired by an antique quilt in which courthouse squares were arranged to look like lanterns, this is a great pattern for beginning quilters as well as more experienced ones.



Four Sizes, from Table Topper to Queen

(Recipe for sherried chicken fingers included.)

023 COUNTRY CHARM

Here's a great way to use charm squares. Made with four-patch squares and half square triangles, this quilt will be satisfying for both beginners and more experienced quilters.

Finished Quilt size—79" x 79"

(Recipe for Dilled Potato Soup included.)



001 BIRTHDAY CAKE



Cake stand blocks are cleverly turned to form stars and crosses on this endlessly interesting quilt. Made with just one block, this quilt is easy to cut and assemble. The use of a striped fabric on the inner border adds interest and dimension. Great as either a lap quilt or a table cover. Finished size—64" x 88" (Recipe for Fabulous Fudge Frosting included.)

003 BLUEBERRY CROSSING

This summery lap quilt will look great on your front porch, draped over a wicker rocker in your sun room or gracing a princess's bedroom. Finished quilt size—81" x 81" (Recipe for Orange Blueberry Scones included.)



005 COZY CABIN

A warm and friendly lap quilt to cheer your family during the Christmas season and beyond. It's fun and easy—containing simple star and cozy cabin blocks. Finished size—63" x 63" (Recipe for Candy Grahams included.)



006 ENCHANTED EVENING

Put on that party dress, tie that bow tie and pour champagne to welcome a new year. Special occasions will sparkle with this enchanting table cover. Silvery white snowballs and colorful bow ties sparkle on this easy, fat quarter friendly pattern. Finished size—60" x 60" (Recipe for Roquefort Grapes included.)

007 LEAFY SKIES

Oh, those crisp fall nights in New Hampshire! The perfume of wood smoke is in the air, and apples are ripe for the picking. Colorful leaves swirl this way and that on a background of deep blue. Make a table runner or lap quilt to evoke this favorite season all year round. Finished size—Table Runner—20" x 56", Lap Quilt—44" x 56" (Recipe for Apple Crisp included.)

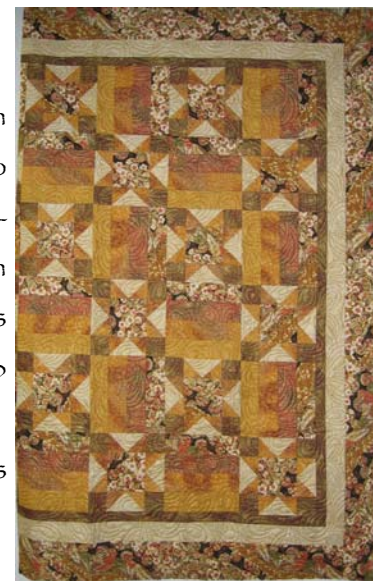


008 LUNCH WITH BECKY

Elegant as Paris in spring, this fat quarter friendly, quick and easy quilt will dress up your wall or table. Make it with a Victorian floral in the center squares, or use a holiday print for a seasonal decoration. Directions are for two sizes—a 45" x 45" wall hanging or table topper, or a 63" x 75" large lap quilt. (Recipe for Café au Chocolat included.)

020 STAIRS TO THE STARS

No one will guess that this is an easy pattern, using only two blocks—the rail fence and the variable star. Great when done in holiday fabrics, this pattern comes in three sizes—a table topper/lap quilt, a twin size, and a queen. (Recipe for Shop Hop Hummus included.)



021 AMISH RAINBOW

An easy, old-fashioned pattern. Make it in batiks or bright marbled fabrics for a modern twist.

Quilt size—66" x 66"
(Recipe for Baked Apple Butter included.)



018 I LOVE FLOWERS

Hearts and flowers are always in season. Make this charmer as a tablecloth, a wall hanging or as a lap or bed quilt. The easy and versatile blocks make this cheerful quilt a snap to put together.

Great with gradations fabric as in the sample. Equally lovely with more traditional fabrics. Try it with batiks for a real treat. (Recipe for Rose Geranium Rolls included.)



019 FLOWER POWER

This cheerful flower-filled quilt is especially lovely when made with batiks. You may choose to make all the flowers the same color, or you may want to dig into your stash to create a cheerful scrappy quilt. Three sizes are included in the pattern—Table—64" x 64", Lap 64" x 76" and Full 88" x 88". (Recipe for Crunchy Granola included)



009 MIDNIGHT SNOWBALL FIGHT

The sky is deep blue, and the snow is falling. Inside, friends gather for hot cocoa and cookies. This table runner will make the party complete. Finished Size—18" x 57" (Recipe for Cheerios Goo Bars included.)

010 MOONLIT REFLECTIONS

Dress up your table (or a door) with this batik runner based on the traditional "rosebud" pattern. So calming when done in cool batiks—spicy when done in warm colors. Fat quarter friendly! Finished size—19" x 67" (Recipe for Summer Slushies included.)



011 SPARE CHANGE

You will want to make this versatile pattern over and over. It looks great in florals, batiks, novelty prints— even baby flannels. You can make any size from a table topper/wall hanging to a king size. Easy and fat quarter friendly!! (Recipe for Presto-Change-o Chocolate Chip Cookies included.)



012 SPOOKY SNAILS

Get ready for the ghosties and ghoulies with this spooky quilt. Use it as a table topper or hang it in your window or on the wall. Finished Size – 44” x 44” (Recipe for Pumpkin Maple Mousse included.)

013 TUSCAN TWILIGHT

Choose warm, sunny and rosy batiks for this table runner and get transported to a terrace in Tuscany, sipping a crisp local wine and nibbling bruschetta toasted over a wood fire. This lovely table runner can double as a wall hanging (looks great on a door). Fat quarter friendly! Finished size 19” x 67” (Recipe for Bruschetta included.)



014 SHORT STACK

Have you shied away from stack-and-whack patterns because they looked too complicated? If so, this is the quilt for you. The “stacked” block centers are simple four patches (no points). Three sizes—lap, twin and queen. (Recipe for As-You Like It Pancakes included.)

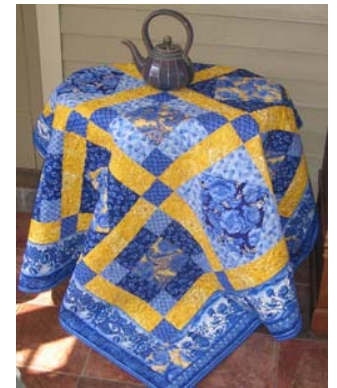


015 PATIO PARTNER REVERSIBLE APRON

Grab your BBQ tools and put some “shrimp on the barbie”. Spilled some sauce on your apron? No worry. It’s reversible. Quick and easy to make, this apron is a great gift. Make matching pot-holders from your scraps! (Recipe for Old Fashioned Barbecue Sauce included.)

016 HIGH TEA

Here’s a great quilt to use those large-scale florals and other prints. Perfect for beginners, it uses just two easy blocks—an uneven nine-patch and a square-in-a-square. Five sizes, from Lap to King. (Recipe for English Trifle included.)



017 TEDDY BEARS IN THE SNOW

Collect bright colored juvenile prints and combine them with white (or white-on-white) fabric to make this charming crib quilt. Have the blocks quilted with teddy bears for a quilt that will be treasured for generations. Finished size—39” x 39” (Recipe for Peppermint Snowflake Pie included.)
